

HLTAID004 Provide an emergency response in an education and care setting**Course Overview:**

Learn the skills and knowledge to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults.

This unit applies to educators and support staff within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies.

Learning Outcomes:

- Respond to emergency situations.
- Apply emergency first aid procedures.
- Respond to unconscious breathing casualty.
- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on an adult, child and infant.
- Use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Apply first aid procedures
- Respond to anaphylaxis and allergic reactions
- Control bleeding
- Respond to choking and airway obstruction
- Apply first aid procedures for fractures, sprains and strains.
- Use immobilisation techniques
- Respond to head injuries
- Respond to poisoning
- Respond to asthma and respiratory distress
- Respond to epilepsy, seizures and convulsions
- Manage shock.
- Learn the state/territory regulations, first aid code of practice and workplace procedures.
- Learn about infection control
- Understand duty of care requirements
- Learn basic anatomy and physiological responses

Industry standards

The Safe Work Australia First Aid Model Code of Practice requires employers to ensure that their nominated first aiders attend training on a regular basis to remain current. The Code of Practice recommends that refresher training in CPR should be undertaken annually and first aid qualifications should be renewed every 3 years to maintain currency.
