

HLTAID003 Provide first aid

Course Overview:

Learn the skills and knowledge to provide a first aid response to a casualty.

This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

This is the current first aid course and many workplaces require their First Aid Officers to hold this Unit of Competency. Previously known as Apply First Aid or Senior First Aid Certificate.

Topic included:

- Management of conscious or unconscious patients
- CPR on Adults and Infants
- External bleeding - trauma and shock
- Respiratory emergencies
- Cardiac emergencies
- Fractures, dislocations and soft tissue injuries
- Head neck and spinal injuries
- Diabetes
- Anaphylaxis
- Seizures / convulsions
- Envenomation, poisoning bites and stings
- Burns
- Hypothermia
- Heat Stroke
- Crush Injuries
- Monitor the condition of the victim
- Follow relevant procedures for recording first aid
- Detail the victims condition & the first aid applied
- Calling Emergency Services

Industry standards

The Safe Work Australia First Aid Model Code of Practice requires employers to ensure that their nominated first aiders attend training on a regular basis to remain current. The Code of Practice recommends that refresher training in CPR should be undertaken annually and first aid qualifications should be renewed every 3 years to maintain currency.

- complete an online learning and theory assessment (2-6 hours). Student are required to complete the online component prior to the workshop delivery.
- attend a one day face-to-face practical and assessment workshop.
